Marching Arts Access, Safety, and Inclusion Network

2022 Collegiate Marching Band Experience Survey

Full Report

This survey was distributed to the marching arts community from January 9th, 2023 through February 15th, 2023. Respondents were required to have participated in a collegiate or university-level marching ensemble during the Fall 2022 season/semester/quarter.

This survey received a total of 73 responses.

Participants reported mixed feelings regarding their experiences with serving in a student leadership position. Participants with negative experiences reported conflict with students and staff, gender-based disrespect, and a heavy workload as factors lowering the quality of their experience. Negative experiences and lack of compensation may lead to student leaders to feel as		

though serving in a leadership role to not be worth the personal cost.

Participants had mixed reactions to their staff and leadership. Many noted that the musical instruction or the content of their education was strong, but the organization, division of responsibilities, and staff commitment widely varied in quality. Issues were often not staff-wide, but rather contained to certain staff members or leaders causing issues in the flow of the ensemble.
